About the list of Sherlockian Purveyors:

The list of Sherlockian Purveyors is a way for you to find all kinds of *things** related to Sherlock Holmes. There are, of course, many, many books, booksellers, and purveyors of written materials of all sorts and then there is a purveyor who sells Sherlock Holmes stained glass chandeliers for your dining room.

This **IS NOT** a list of what is for sale. That would be an impossible job! This is a list of *who sells what*.

I do not propose in any way that this is an all-inclusive list but I have tried to find and put in this database as many places as you might want to buy something relating to Sherlock Holmes.

The list generally does not include large publishers or organizations who may only sell one or two things about Sherlock Holmes. It does not include non-Sherlockian magazines which may have one article about Sherlock Holmes in one issue. This list is for things that are for sale by someone. These days a check on Amazon is usually the quickest way to find something written. This being the 21st century, I must also say that Amazon is also a great way to find and buy books and other items. As of January 2012, Amazon lists 17,422 "Sherlock" items.

If you are searching for information I suggest you go to Google which, last time I checked, had about 331,000,000 (!) links to "Sherlock Holmes."

I welcome all editions changes and corrections. Since some of these items are offered only for a limited time I particularly appreciate knowing when something is **not** available or some organization has ceased to sell Sherlockian things. If I learn of a specific link to a specific item (www.teacozey.com/sherlock/blue/cozy.html) I will shorten it to www.teacozey.com since exact

URLs to aspecific items often change, but the purveyor may still be in business and selling similar things.

A word about phone numbers: For organizations outside of the North American Numbering System (XXX-XXX-XXXX) you may have to do some research. In some cases the organizations include the international dialing prefix and code from the USA and some do not. If you are placing the call from other than the country code of the organization itself, other digits may be needed. I suggest you look at <http://www.countrycallingcodes.com/> or similar websites to guide you through the maze particularly if you are calling Tanzania from Tonga. Oh, and be ready for “The number you have reached is not in service.” in 164 languages!
